Before you put your home on the market, make sure all the routine maintenance has been taken care of. Making the investment up front will pay off in the end. It will help attract buyers in this very competitive market.

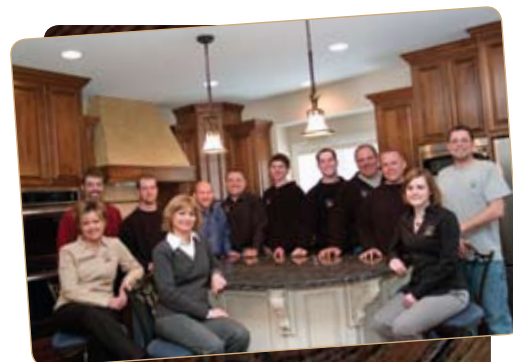
